Easter Sunday Kids' Talk

Thank you for using the 'Quiz Worx Home Delivery' Discussion Questions and 'Digging Deeper' family devotions. We hope this resource is a blessing to you and your family as you remember Jesus, who beat death and made a way for us to live forever with God. Firstly, you will find some questions that relate directly to the Kids' Talk video. You can use these to lead a short discussion at any time after watching the video. If you have older children, they might like to work through these questions themselves.

Secondly, we have provided some further questions based around John 20. We encourage you to read the passages with those in your household at a time that suits, and use the questions to guide you as you talk and reflect on the events of Easter Sunday. Below you will find some notes on these passages to help you.

(Most weeks we will only be releasing one kids talk video, and so the further questions can be spread out throughout the week. This Easter Weekend we have released a Good Friday talk AND an Easter Sunday talk, both of which have further discussion questions. As a family you can decide how best to spread these out through the week).

We looked at the NIV, ESV and CEV Bible translations when creating these questions. Any one of these would be fine to use as you work through them during your family Blble time.

Discussion Questions after "The Living, Peace Bringing, Sending King" video

- 1. Who was the first person to see Jesus alive?
- 2. Where were the disciples?
- 3. Jesus greeted them by saying "Peace be with you". What did he mean?
- 4. What did Jesus tell the disciples to do?
- 5. What are some practical ways we can "go" and share this message with people when we aren't even allowed out of our homes?

Pray together – Thanking God that Jesus is alive and brings us peace with God. Think of specific people we can share the message of Jesus with. Ask God to help us tell others about Jesus.

Digging Deeper

Family Devotions



This family Bible devotion will take you through John 20:1-23 as you follow the people who were there when Jesus rose from the dead. Celebrate this incredible news with those in your household as you read the passages and discuss the questions. We encourage you to think about how each person would have felt at each point in the narrative: before and after they see and realise that Jesus is alive!

Read together John 20:1-10

- 1. How do you think Mary felt, going to the tomb?
- 2. What did Simon Peter, and the other disciple see in the tomb?

Read together John 20:11-18

- 1. Who did Mary think was talking to her?
- 2. What did Jesus tell Mary to do?

Read together John 20:19-23

- 1. How were the disciples feeling, when they were in the room?
- 2. How did they feel, after Jesus showed his hands and feet?
- 3. Discuss what Jesus says to them and what he tells them to do
- 4. How does it make you feel to know that Jesus is alive?
- 5. What should we do now?

Jesus is alive! Spend time praying together, thanking God for sending Jesus to die on the cross for our sins then raising him back to life so we can live forever for him. Pray for those people in your lives that you want to share this Good News with.
